Student 1 Doctor

- give recommendations

Student 2 Patient

- introduce yourself
- tell how you feel
- tell what's wrong with you
- describe symptoms
- thank the doctor

Could you repeat please?

Stay at home for a week\ 3 days.

Take the pills 3 times a day after meals.

Gargle your throat \ teeth

Drink warm tea with lemon.

Don't eat sweets\ fast food

Wash hands before meals.

Wash fruit and vegetables .

Walk in the fresh air.

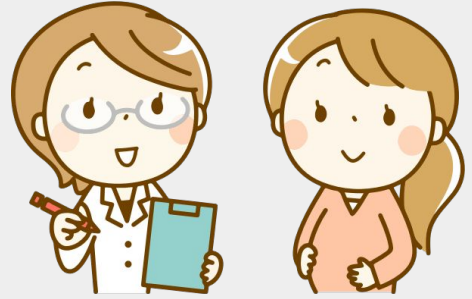
Brush your teeth twice a day after meals.
